- First aid Kit - (mostly Band-Aids)
- Paper towels

- Liquid soap for bottom of pans
- Insect Repellent - Remember to check for ticks
- Toothbrush and Paste

- Mess kit (cup, bowl, fork, knife, spoon or (Spork))
- Stove - & - Tent if you have one – or borrow from Troop
- Cooking and Cleaning gear as needed for what the Patrol is cooking.

- Optional Frisbee / nerf football / games for ferry / stuff for camp & beach/camp chair

Bikes - We are renting bikes on the island. It includes helmets witch are required – no exceptions.
Helmets– Required by the BSA for SCOUTS & ADULTS

Tents and gear can go in the Troop Truck, it will minimize what you carry on the ferry – You will not see the Troop Truck again until Saturday morning on the island.

Gear Drop Off to the Troop Truck

All gear must be dropped off at St. John's on **Thursday night October 10th between 6 and 8 PM.**

Nothing can be loose.

Do not tie everything together.

No open grocery bags.

Mark everything with masking or duct tape.

You can bring your own helmet – but keep it with you and bring it on the ferry.
