### Gear Drop Off to the Troop Truck

All gear must be dropped off at St. John's on <u>Thursday night October 10<sup>th</sup> between 6 and 8 PM.</u> <u>Nothing can be loose.</u> <u>Do not tie everything together.</u> <u>No open grocery bags.</u> <u>Mark everything with masking or duct tape</u>. You can bring your own helmet – but keep it with you and bring it on the ferry.
